Long March Space is pleased to present the solo exhibition "Wang Sishun: Apocalyp se". This is the second exhibition of the artist held at Long March Space. Wang's I atest creation *Apocalypse*, stones that the artist hand-picked based on their resembl ance of human portraits, from all over the world including Russia, France, Italy and various areas of China, will take center stage of the exhibition. The stones are of different sizes, shapes, colours and textures. It seems as though they could come fr om various worlds, races and identities. They are lives from both the past and the future, with distinct dispositions: some possess spirits that are wholesome, while oth ers are maleficent; some are divine, while others are grotesque. All of these lives a nd characters come together to create a world of both conflict and harmony.

From Wang Sishun's previous works: *Uncertain Capital* (2009 - ongoing), *Fruit* (2014 - ongoing), *Abyss* (2014 - ongoing), *Truth* (2014 - ongoing) etc., one can observe his long-standing interest in natural laws and social mechanisms. His work is typicall y concerned with time and duration, which once started continues to evoke powerfu I imagination and unknown potentials. The artist employs the same methodology for this exhibition, allowing the work to assume a life of its own and through a unique intervention finally reveals its meaning.

Wang Sishun was born in 1979 in Wuhan, China. He graduated from the Departme nt of Sculpture at the Central Academy of Fine Arts in 2008. Wang's practice is co nceptual, expressed through a wide range of mediums from sculpture, performance, drawing, photograph and video. The core of his practice is to investigate the interc hangeable relationships between substances and materials.

The exhibition opens on the 28<sup>th</sup> of April 2016 and will continue until the 26<sup>th</sup> of M ay.
